Content Delivery Networks ("CDNs") - No Core HR Data

We use a content delivery networks ("CDNs") for security purposes, and to optimize content delivery. CDNs guard applications exposed to the internet against man-in-the-middle attacks, data breaches, and attempts to overwhelm the network of the targeted origin server using DDoS attacks. CDNs do not have access to HR Core Data, however, website content served to website visitors and domain name information may be stored with a CDN to expedite transmission, and information transmitted across a CDN may be accessed by that CDN to enable its functions.
